2014 Regulation Changes

VIFs

New electronic VIFs are required for this year and beyond, I would like to think all competitors should have enough time over the winter to have them completed.

The old style forms not be valid after 1st of June 2014.

Cars without a valid VIF will be entered in the Invitation Class they will not be classified in race results or be eligible for 70s Road Sports championship points

The onus is on the competitor to have their car inspected, that means making the arrangements with the Registrar.

VIFs will only be valid for the car and the current owner, if the car is sold it will be the responsibility of the next owner to apply for a new VIF.
